

A FUN, EDUCATIONAL AND INTERACTIVE PRESENTATION **BY ALEX A.!**

Alex A. begins his presentation by talking about the series and its hero Super Agent Jon Le Bon. He explains how he began writing and illustrating graphic novels at the very young age of 8. Then, with Alex's drawing tricks and writing tips, the participants are invited to express their own creativity by developing characters and drawing them. EQUIPMENT NEEDED: an interactive whiteboard or a projector or a large easel with a notepad and black markers.
